Verses 14-19

What is the “reason” Paul is referring to in verse 14?

Rephrase the following:

Bow my knees  
He may grant you  
Strengthened with power  
In your inner being  
Rooted and grounded in love  
May be filled  
Fullness of God

What is the significance of being “named”? What does this tell you about God?

In your life, what does it look like to be rooted and grounded in God’s love? What is evident when this is true of you (actions, speech, attitude, etc.)?

Summarize this section into an action statement.

Verses 20-21

When have you asked God for something and received much more than you asked?  
Did that change the way you pray to or seek after God?

How are you, as part of the church, bringing glory to God?
